


Connect to the OLLU Devices Network

Step 1. Login to My Devices portal:

<https://devices.ollusa.edu/>

Enter your OLLU username and password:


Example: username **Jahmed** not Jahmed@ollusa.edu

Step 4. Click Submit and device will show up on the list:

To add a new device, enter the device ID, which displays on your device as the MAC or Wi-Fi address. It consists of 6 alphanumeric number pairs separated by colons such as AA:BB:CC:11:22:33.

Step 5. Connect your consumer device to the “OLLUDevices” wireless network in your device’s network settings. Launch or open the device (example - Firestick, Roku, or TV,) and connect the OLLU Devices network in the list of wireless internet options. After your device shows it is connected you are ready for use.

Connect to the OLLU Devices Network

Examples of how to find your Mac Address

Android

1. Tap on the **Apps** icon from your device's Home screen.
2. Tap on the **Settings** icon.
3. Tap on the **About device** icon (or **About Phone** on some devices).
4. Tap on **Status**.
5. Look for your device's Mac Address below **Wi-Fi MAC Address**.

Amazon Echo

1. Open the Alexa App .
2. Select **Devices** .
3. Select **Echo & Alexa**.
4. Select your device.
5. Select **Change** next to **Wi-Fi Network** and follow the instructions in the app.

Amazon Fire Stick

1. From the Home screen, press **Menu**.
2. Select **Settings**. You should see the Wi-Fi MAC Address located in the **Device Info** section.

Apple TV

1. Go to **Settings**.

2. Select **General**.
3. Select **About**. In the About page, you should see your MAC Address (it might be listed as **Wi-Fi Address**).

Nintendo 3DS

1. Go to **System Settings**.
2. Tap on **Internet Settings**.
3. Tap **Other Information**.
4. Tap **Confirm MAC Address**. The MAC Address will be displayed on your screen.

Nintendo Wii

1. From the Wii main menu, select the **Wii** button.
2. Select **Wii Settings**.
3. From the Wii System Settings menu, navigate to the second page using the right-pointing arrow, and then select **Internet**.
4. Select **Console Information**. The MAC Address will be displayed. (**Note:** Make sure to use 'MAC Address', **not** 'LAN Adapter MAC Address'.)

Nintendo Wii U

1. From the Wii U menu, select **System Settings**.
2. Select the **Internet** icon and press the **A** button.
3. Select **View MAC Address**. Your MAC Address will be displayed. (**Note:** Make sure to use 'MAC Address', **not** 'LAN Adapter MAC Address'.)

You can find the **MAC Address** of your Roku device on the bottom or back of your Roku player (depending on the model).

Sony PlayStation 3

1. Power up the PlayStation 3 without a disk in the drive.
2. From the PS3 main menu, select **Settings**.
3. Select **System Settings**.
4. Select **System Information**. Your *MAC Address (Wi-Fi)* will be displayed.

Sony PlayStation 4

1. Power up the PlayStation 4 without a disk in the drive.
2. From the PS4 main menu, select **Settings**.
3. From the Settings page, select **System**.
4. From the System page, select **System Information**. Your *MAC Address (Wi-Fi)* will be displayed.

Sony PlayStation Vita

1. From the home screen, go to **Settings**.
2. From the Settings screen, go to **System**.
3. From the System screen, go to **System Information**. Your device's MAC Address will be displayed.

Xbox One

Connect to the OLLU Devices Network

1. Sign in to your profile.
2. Select **My Games & Apps**.
3. Select **Settings**.
4. Select **Network**.
5. Select **Advanced Settings**. The **Wireless MAC** Address will be displayed on the right-hand side of your screen.

Xbox 360

1. On your console, go to My Xbox, and then select **System Settings**.
2. Select **Network Settings**.
3. If prompted, select **GURegistered**.
4. Select **Configure Network**.

Samsung TV

1. Press Menu.
2. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Network, then press ENTER.
3. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight Network Settings, then press ENTER.
4. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **WIRED**, then press ENTER. (Note that the wired MAC address and the wireless MAC address are different)
5. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Network Test**, then press ENTER.
6. The MAC address needed to register your Samsung Smart TV will be listed as either **Ethernet Address** or **Wired MAC Address** at the top of the screen.

Sharp TV

1. Press the Menu on the remote.
2. Press < or > to highlight Initial Setup, then press Enter.

3. Press ▲ or ▼ to select Internet Setup, then press Enter.
4. Press ▲ or ▼ to select Network Setup, then press Enter.
5. Press ▲ or ▼ to select Connection Type, then press Enter.
6. Press < or > to highlight WIRED, then press Enter.
7. Press ▲ or ▼ to select IP Setup, then press Enter.
8. The MAC Address should be on the bottom of the page.

Sony TV

Older TVs

1. Press the **Home** button.
2. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Settings**, then press **Enter**.
3. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Network Setup**, then press **Enter**.
4. From the menu, select **Wired Setup**, then press **Enter**.
5. Click on **Network Setup – Status** and the **MAC Address** should be on the screen.

Newer TVs

1. Press the **Home** button.
2. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Settings**, then press **Enter**.
3. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Preferences**, then press **Enter**.
4. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Setup**, then press **Enter**.
5. Use the arrow keys to scroll to **Network Setup**, then press **Enter**.
6. Click on **Network Setup – Status** and the **MAC Address** should be on the screen. Please ensure it says Wired and not Wireless.

Visio TV

1. Press **Menu** on the remote.
2. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight the **Network**, then press **OK**.
3. The **Network Connection** menu displays.
4. Press ▲ or ▼ to highlight **Manual Setup**, Then press **OK**. The IP Settings menu is displayed.
5. At the bottom of the menu the **RJ45 MAC** addresses is displayed. (Do not register the wireless MAC address)
